

AFC Construction COVID-19 Site Policies

- At the beginning of each shift, all Foreman are required to talk to their workers asking if anyone is feeling sick or showing any symptoms of COVID-19 (Cough, sore throat, fever, shortness of breath) and if they have come into contact with anyone having or showing any symptoms of COVID-19
- All workers will be required to fill out the COVID-19 health check questionnaire
- All new workers coming on site will receive a verbal orientation, showing them the Site Safety Board and site particulars; told who the first aid attendant is; and location of the fire extinguishers & air horn stations
- Foreman will conduct staff sign in at the start and end of each day – via verbal or text and provide to the Superintendent
- Contact numbers are posted on the site office door
- There will be limited access to the site office; except for the first aid room
- Extra hand washing stations and sanitizers locations have been installed on site. Everyone is required to wash their hands regularly throughout the day. (IE before and after using the washroom / before and after your breaks)
- Sub trades are asked to bring their own spray bottle for sanitizing of work areas and tools. Cleaning solution will be provided by AFC
- Tools are to be cleaned at the beginning and end of each shift
- No sharing tools or PPE
- Workers having to work within the 2 m social zone must wear safety glasses and a mask or respirator
- Workers are required to stagger their breaks and maintain the 2 m social distance rule.
- No sunflower seeds (or similar shelled food); no gum; no spitting; and no chewing tobacco on site
- It is suggested that workers travel on their own to and from work. Car-pooling is not recommended

These policies are as of March 27, 2020 and will be updated as BC health and WCB advise
